# 1 INTRODUCTION

- 1.1 The ESPRESSO tool is a spreadsheet that provides estimates of total tax and total expenditure within an area. As a result, it uses a multitude of data sources and calculation methodologies to identify and match these data sources as accurately as possible.
- 1.2 This paper outlines the methodologies used to ascertain the relevant data, and the original sources of the data.

## 2 GENERAL PRINCIPLES

2.1 In order to apply a consistent methodology to the sourcing and disaggregation of data to the local level, a range of principles have been established. These principles guide both the sourcing of the data, and the appropriate methodology used.

2.2 The general principles are:

- **Local data first:** where data already exists at a lower geographic level than national, that dataset is preferable. The lower the geographic level of the data, the more likely they are to be used. This may mean, for example, that data on local authority or regional tax or expenditure are used in place of UK-wide data. No expenditure or tax data are used or provided at a level lower than local authority. However, some disaggregation methodologies do utilise LSOA population data to disaggregate expenditure to a local authority level.
- **Larger datasets:** datasets covering larger geographies or multiple themes are chosen above more complex or detailed datasets that may only cover one element of the overall data. This is to help maintain consistency across a wide variety of data.
- **Fewer datasets:** to limit the number of datasets from which data are drawn to calculate relevant information. The most complicated calculations and disaggregations increase the likelihood of inaccuracies and lack of comparability.
- **National or government statistics above independently produced data:** while independently produced statistics may provide further insight, or reduce the likelihood for miscalculations, it was felt that to ensure consistency, national statistics or government-provided data would be a better choice.
- **Reported financial figures above independent estimates:** where national figures are not available, financial figures reported by the relevant organisation are preferable over independently produced figures.
- **Appropriate disaggregation denominators:** appropriate disaggregation denominators have been chosen to support a more accurate view of the data. For many areas, a simple disaggregation of national tax or expenditure would be by population. And yet many taxes are not collected on a per person basis, while most public sector expenditure is not based on the total population of an area. As a result, appropriate methodologies for disaggregating national, regional or non-district data down to the district are chosen above a standard disaggregation by population.
- **Removing accounting practices from reported figures:** several datasets, especially around financial estimates of expenditure, include financial accounting adjustments that do not represent real changes in expenditure. For example, as the fire services came together in Scotland, Fire Scotland reported a significant expenditure in the first year as an adjustment identifying legacy liabilities. This adjustment - referencing the shifting of premises and pensions liabilities -

constituted about 4 years' worth of annual revenue expenditure. It was thus removed from the expenditure figures.

- **Balancing availability and accuracy:** one of the primary concerns is in balancing accuracy of information and disaggregations with the availability of data as a whole. Tax data, for example, are provided at a UK and nation level - we have taken the nation level, accepting the HMRC breakdown of tax receipts by nation rather than calculating a breakdown based on other models.
- **Accounting for spend by the agency directly expending the monies:** there are several examples within the data where there have been intra-agency payments. As an example, funding for Transport for Greater Manchester is initially provided to the Greater Manchester Combined Authority and then passed on. The approach taken here is to identify the organisation that spends the public funding, and the geography at which they spend it. This also aims to avoid double-counting, where two organisations report the same funding within their accounts.
- **Final data above reported budgets:** the analysis has used outturn data first, utilising budget data only where this information is unavailable. This ensures greater accuracy in terms of overall spend.
- **Net current expenditure rather than gross:** only one expenditure figure is provided: net current expenditure. The various datasets include both income and gross expenditure figures. However, to provide a more accurate estimation of the reliance of an area on HM Treasury, net current expenditure is the only figure reported.
- **Identifying both revenue and capital expenditure:** the ESPRESSO tool includes breakdowns for both capital and revenue expenditure, in order to provide options for a more fine-grain analysis of the data.

2.3 A more general approach has been to differentiate public sector expenditure between direct expenditure on public service delivery and national spend that does not have a specific geographic focus. This highlights a specific caveat to the use of the data: much of the national spend is still geographically focused (e.g. Whitehall expenditure in central government functions, MoJ expenditure at specific court locations, MoD expenditure at specific military bases).

2.4 The analysis has summed all national government expenditure and then disaggregated down to the local level. As more data become available, the ESPRESSO tool will be expanded to consider how national government expenditure can be geographically disaggregated.

## 3 TAX DATA

- 3.1 Tax data come from a variety of sources. There are multiple options to source total expenditure, however the main source has been the national disaggregations of tax receipts provided directly by HMRC.
- 3.2 Where data are not already provided at a local level, a disaggregation methodology has been applied. The main disaggregation method is by population, from the annual Mid-Year Population Estimates produced by ONS. However, in many cases a weighted proportion is identified - for example, to calculate Vehicle Excise Duty, the total number of registered vehicles is multiplied by the average national licence value for each body type in each area, and this is used to apportion out the total national VED receipts.
- 3.3 Some of the calculations are relatively complex, as the apportionment methodology uses a series of weighted values. For example, the income tax figure is split by the estimated income tax paid on the average salary for each area, multiplied by the number in employment in the area.
- 3.4 The table in Appendix A shows how the disaggregations of tax data have been made to the local authority level, including explanatory notes and data sources.

## 4 EXPENDITURE DATA

- 4.1 Expenditure data come from a wider variety of sources than tax data. This is because public sector expenditure covers a much wider array of agencies and organisations, as well as broad themes and categories of spend, than tax data. The complication of tax data is largely in the multiple rules around what specifically is taxed, and how that tax applies geographically. In comparison, expenditure data are complex in that multiple organisations, covering multiple geographies, spend public monies according to various expenditure rules.
- 4.2 Much of the local government expenditure known is provided through DCLG's outturn data on revenue and capital expenditure. However, not all local public sector expenditure is spent through local authorities. Multiple other organisations are funded through several organisations or departments. For example, public protection funding goes through local police and local authorities, depending on the focus of the funding.
- 4.3 Though there are multiple sources of data, the main sources of public sector expenditure are DCLG's aforementioned revenue and capital outturn statistics; the Department for Work and Pensions' benefit expenditure data; the Public Expenditure Statistical Analyses (for central government expenditure); NHS England; StatsWales; and the Scottish Government.
- 4.4 Where data are not already provided at a local level, a disaggregation methodology has been applied. As with tax data, the main disaggregation method is by population, taking population from annual Mid-Year Population Estimates, produced by ONS. For police and crime commissioner expenditure, this is split by numbers of crimes per year, taken from national statistics. In many cases, this is not provided to a local level, and so a population disaggregation has been added to a crime disaggregation.
- 4.5 For CCG areas, the ONS lookup for LSOAs to CCGs was used alongside population estimates by LSOA from ONS. This was used to apportion expenditure to different local areas, especially where one area was contained (at least partially) within more than one CCG. Around 40% of CCGs covered more than one local authority area.
- 4.6 The disaggregation to local areas was based on the local areas that the particular authority covered. This may produce some erroneous results, especially where authorities responsible for expenditure did not wholly cover an area. In the case of National Park Authorities, where no direct look-up was available, the split has been based on the entire population of the areas covered, even if the national park covers only a portion of that area. For example, the Peak District National Park only partly covers Oldham, and yet the entire Oldham population has been used to calculate the proportion of spend by the National Park Authority within Oldham.
- 4.7 The table in Appendix B shows how the disaggregations of the expenditure data have been made to the local authority level.

## 5 FUTURE DEVELOPMENTS

- 5.1 The ESPRESSO tool will continue to be developed, and will primarily focus on four areas of work: adding new data; evolving methodologies; improving the tool's usability; and supporting the drive for more data availability.

### New data

- 5.2 In addition to adding in data for further years – including pre-2013 and post-2015 – the ESPRESSO team will continue to look for new data sources meeting with the general principles outlined above.
- 5.3 Additional data sources have already been outlined that could support the ESPRESSO tool, and the team will explore their efficacy. Identified areas of spend include further breakdowns for Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland, as well as a better understanding of education and skills spending within the UK more generally.
- 5.4 Where further data are identified that would also help to better identify geographically accurate national government spend, the ESPRESSO team will aim to identify how this can be incorporated into the work.

### Improving and evolving methodologies

- 5.5 The current methodologies for disaggregating data to a local level will continue to be assessed, and where improvements can be made these will be added to new releases of the ESPRESSO tool.
- 5.6 Several areas have already been identified where additional or variant methodologies could be applied. One of these areas is in the disaggregation of income tax. Currently, this is based on where income is earned rather than on where the employee lives. As a result, the methodology increases tax take in areas of high employment or high-value employment, and reduces it in areas of high net out-commuting. An option for switching between workplace-based and residence-based methodologies is currently being considered.
- 5.7 Additionally, other taxes may largely be based on sales rather than residence, and as such additional variant methodologies may also be explored, using GVA as a disaggregating factor.

### Improve the ESPRESSO tool

- 5.8 The ESPRESSO tool is currently an Excel spreadsheet – two sheets with the relevant data, a pivot table displaying this information and various macros that support this work.
- 5.9 The longer-term aim of the ESPRESSO tool is to make it more widely available and more widely used. This relies on having a simple user interface that allows users to

access the data. We will continue to explore options for improving the usability of the data, improving the user interface and providing new tools to explore the data.

**Support the drive for greater data accessibility**

- 5.10** ESPRESSO relies on the use of existing open data in set formats. Large sections of data – especially expenditure data provided at the local authority level – are from existing open datasets. However, a significant portion of the data sources are from individual financial reports and accounts.
- 5.11** The ESPRESSO team will continue to support the creation of open data sets, and will continue to support the use of these datasets.
